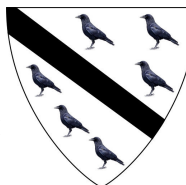

June is a busy month for many people. Youngsters are busy with exams - GCSEs, A levels, degree finals. Gardeners are busy, especially after the rain in May. The church is also busy. This year Pentecost (or Whitsun for those of us over 21), Trinity and Corpus Christi all fall in June. We also celebrate the feast days of many famous and not so famous saints. Have you heard of Boniface, Colomba, Richard of Chichester, Etheldreda or Irenaeus?

St John the Baptist and St Peter are better known - John the Baptist marks midsummer on 24th June, and St Peter is commemorated on 29th June.

And it's at Pentecost that men and women are ordained as priests and deacons in the Church of England. Ordination has been in the news lately, as in May the church celebrated 20 years since women were first

ordained. There have been special services all around the country, and the women who were the very first to be ordained in 1994 were honoured in a special service at St Paul's cathedral.

The ordination of women reminds us that change is part of creation and that nothing is impossible for God. Ordinations on St Peter's day reminds us that ordinary human beings, like the passionate but fallible fisherman Peter, are capable of great things.

You may not all feel called to the priesthood, but amidst the busy-ness of June, keep some space to reflect on your life. Do you want to be a nuclear physicist? Or play the trombone? Or go on the prayer rota? Whatever it is, don't be afraid to have a go - remember nothing is impossible for God.
