If that doesn't appeal, have a think about these words from Rowan Williams, who writes that Lent is a time to:

"Sweep and clean the room of our own minds and hearts so that the new life really may have room to come in and take over and transform us at Easter".

Here we are minded that Lent is a time of preparation for Easter; a time to sweep away the old and make room for the new. So how do we do this?

It may be that giving up something you like (and chocolate is an old favourite) enables you to create that space for the new life and transformation of Easter. Or you could try praying - praying every day in Lent in an

If you don't have a computer you could spend a few minutes each day praying for the people in the headlines of the news, or for your families and neighbours. Praying for others often illuminates things in our own lives that perhaps we need to sweep or clean.

But if you do want to spend Lent springcleaning, you would be very welcome at the vicarage at any time!
